

Code for Parents/Guardians at Leopardstown Tennis Club

Parents/Guardians in LTC are expected to –

- Ensure your child understands and abides by their Code of Conduct.

- Know your child's training programme and accept it is your responsibility for their timely delivery and collection.
- Respect and abide by the decisions made by the Committee, Coaches and Leaders.
- Be a role model for your children by maintaining the highest standards of personal conduct and respectful behaviour towards *everyone* at the club.
- If you wish to raise an issue with a committee member, coach or leader, it should be done in an appropriate manner and at an appropriate time.
- Feel free to put forward suggestions and comments.
- Promote fair play and the positive aspects of tennis with your child.
- Encourage and allow your child to focus their efforts and success in terms of their goals rather than winning being the main objective.
- Always respect and recognise the value and importance of the officials and volunteers who provide sporting opportunities for your child.
